What is Zoiper for Windows Mobile?

Zoiper for Windows mobile is a software application for Windows Mobile 5 and above.

Supported features:

- SIP
- IAX2
- Outbound proxy
- Register on startup
- STUN
- Contact list
- Supported codecs:
 - GSM
 - U-LAW
 - A-LAW
 - Speex
- Call history

3G and GPRS and bluetooth are not supported yet. We have them in our To-Do list.

Zoiper Mobile is still only available for Windows Mobile.

Zoiper for iOS is also available for iPod, iPad and iPhone.

Zoiper for Android is still under development.

How to install and configure Zoiper for Windows Mobile?

Installation:

Download the .CAB file from our [website](#) and upload it to your Mobile device.

You can do this by copying it to your removable memory card or by using a cable to upload it on your phone.

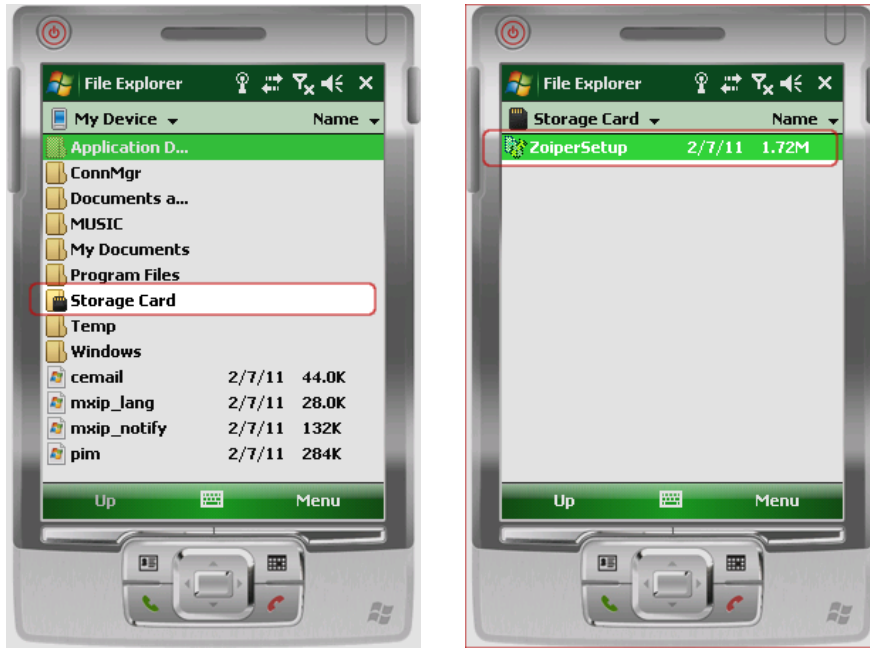
When using cable connection you will need to have ActiveSync installed on your computer. When connected, the mobile device will appear as "Mobile Device" in Windows Explorer.

After the CAB is stored on your mobile device you can disconnect it.

You will need to do so, if you would like to install Zoiper on your memory card.

Use the file explorer to browse to the folder where you uploaded the CAB file.

HOW TO INSTALL AND CONFIGURE ZOIPER FOR WINDOWS MOBILE



Click on it to start the installation process and follow the onscreen instructions.

Choose where to install Zoiper – on the internal memory, or on your device.



After Zoiper Mobile is successfully installed, you can delete the CAB file from your device.

Now you can find it in your Programs menu:



Account setup:

When you start Zoiper for first time, you will see the New account wizard.

Fill in your details the corresponding fields and press Save.

- **"Type"** of the account can be SIP or IAX2.
- **"Name"** stands for the name of the account.
- **"Username"** stands for your VoIP account username.
- **"Password"** fill in the password for your VoIP account.
- **"Domain"** is the name or IP address of the VoIP server.
- **"Outbound proxy"** outbound proxy for the VoIP account.
- **"Auth. Username"** is the authentication username for your VoIP account, if it differs from the username.
- **"Phone"** enter your extension here.
- **"Caller identity"** type your desired name here. It is what will be shown on the other side, if the VoIP server allows.
- **"Re-register time"** time interval for re-registration of the VoIP account with the server (in seconds).
- **"Register on startup"** your account will register when Zoiper starts.
- **"Enable STUN"** if you need to use STUN.

The list of accounts:

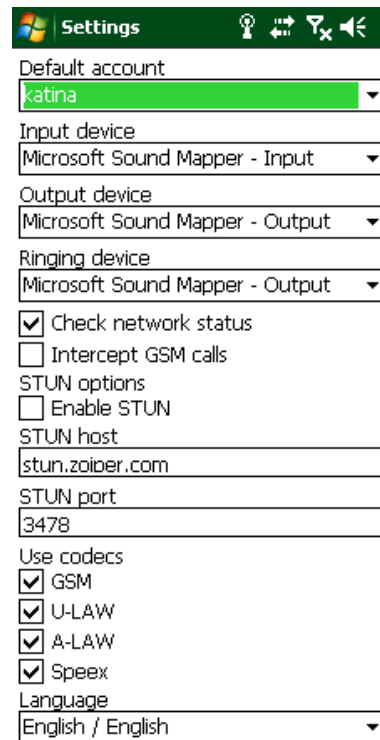


You can use the buttons to register/unregister the account with the VoIP server.

You can edit the account from the Menu.

Here you can configure the following options:

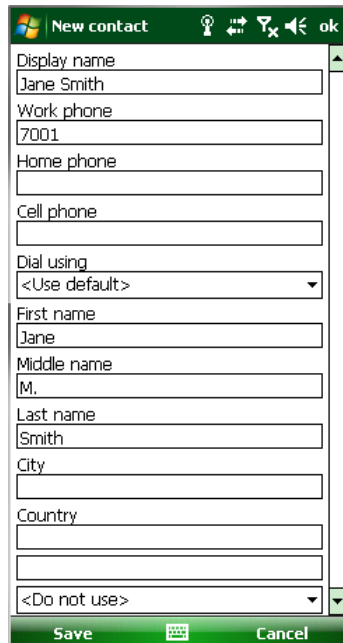
- *Default account*
- *Input audio device*
- *Output audio device*
- *Ringing device*
- *Check network status*
- *Policy against GSM calls*
- *STUN properties*
- *Audio codecs*
- *Language.*



Adding contacts

To add a new contact select Contact, then "Add new contact".

Enter your contact details in the appropriate fields. Later you can dial this contact using your VoIP account. You can also use the onscreen keyboard to search among the contacts.



Placing calls

You can re-dial and search in the call history.



Example configuration for Asterisk

The example below is showing a SIP account and its extension.

Frequently asked questions:

Q: "I am unable to install Zoiper Mobile on my Windows Mobile device.

Here is the error I see: "untrusted certificate or component missing". "

A: *The installer and the application are not signed. This is still a Beta.*

In the final version they will be signed.

There is a workaround - alter your device settings so installing unsigned applications to be allowed.

Q: "Will Zoiper support my Windows Phone 7 device?"

A: *At this time zoiper does not support Windows phone 7 due to certain intentional limitations of the platform.*

Unlike Android and Iphone, Windows phone 7 does not allow the use of native code.

For us it is nearly impossible to do audio and video compression properly.

We hope the possibility for native code will be offered in the future.
